INTENT: The intent and philosophy of CPI is to provide the best care, welfare, safety and security at any given moment to the individuals in your charge even in violent moments.

REMINDER: In an effort to meet the Colorado State Board of Education Rules for the Administration of the Protection of Persons from Restraint Act, specifically: R-2.03 Staff Training – “All public educational programs shall ensure that staff utilizing restraint in schools or facilities are trained. Training shall include:

- 2.03(1) a continuum of prevention techniques;
- 2.03(2) environmental management;
- 2.03(3) a continuum of de-escalation techniques;
- 2.03(4) nationally recognized physical management and restraint, including, but not limited to, techniques that allow restraint in an upright or sitting position;
- 2.03(5) methods to explain the use of restraint to the student who is to be restrained and to the individual’s family; and
- 2.03(6) appropriate documentation and notification procedures.”

You must attend both days to get certified for CPI
