One of Jason's directives from his evaluation is to evaluate the Leadership staff, which are those people here at the office. He reported that all of those evaluations were finalized in June. We had been doing them and then during Covid it was not done. We now are back on track.

Diana Elliott asked if the paraprofessionals in the center-based programs were evaluated. Nicole Kollath shared that yes, they use do a self-evaluation at the beginning of the year, and teachers are doing an evaluation with the at beginning, mid and end of year.

B. Additional Staff Reports – Enclosed

Beverly Blagg shared that they are finalizing topics for the Fall Inservice with SPED staff. One of the topics is AI and how to use it with SPED students. Also focusing on specially designed instruction for students. We have had a great start to the school year so far.

Mitzi Swiatkowski shared that we received \$50,000 more in Perkins because of Strasburg, Bennet and Elbert School Districts were up more than 30%. We plan to buy welding equipment for Ag. Programs.

Megan Eikleberry shared that the Consolidated Application revisions have been done so as soon as we hear from CDE we can start using those funds.

C. Quarterly Financial Report

Craig shared that we have a few new finance people in our districts this year so he would be willing to help support any or all of them. He will also be setting up some meetings throughout the year for professional development. Please encourage your Business Directors to attend.
